Loss of views into + out of Saxon meadow is not legally compliant as the council does not seem to have considered their former plan + ignored representations from their own external advisers about the existing plan being too dense - the number of houses proposed. The current plan is to increase the number by approx 30% + I do not feel the council has been clear or transparent in the reasons why they have increased the number of houses. The plan is not legally compliant because the negative impact on the views amenity enjoyed by the residents both into Saxon meadow + from Saxon meadows which include the historic spine of Chichester Cathedral (see photos). The plan is not sound because it fails to take into account the protection of designated conservation area (p11) and will destroy these views as well as the amenity to fly my model aircraft and have open amenity space surrounding Saxon meadow for the benefit of all residents of Saxon meadow + they are generally for relaxation, recreation, dog walking, etc - important for mental health.

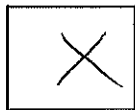
