At Peak times Google Maps advises avoiding the A27 and going through the city when driving East/West from Tangmere. The bypass (built in 1930) and constantly modified is totally at maximum capacity. Building 1300 new homes in the village (2000 cars approx) plus the huge existing work at Fontwell and proposed building at North Burstead will result in gridlock. This is without taking into account more building west of the city toward Havent. There has not been a rail link for Tangmere since 1962 and the 55 bus is expensive and has a very limited capacity and timetable.
