I am responding on behalf of the Education Department at West Sussex County Council (WSCC). We liaised on the masterplan last year, prior to submission, with DLBP planners (representing the landowners), maintained primary schools in the area (Plaistow and Kirdford, Loxwood and Wisborough Green) and strategic planners at WSCC and Chichester District Council on the need for a primary school.

At the time the developers asked for education advice on the need for a new primary school. As this was ahead of the Local Plan process housing numbers for the area had not been finalised or consulted on. Nonetheless, in order to encourage good place shaping, it was suggested a primary school site should identified. If this was not required it could be taken out, rather than for education to ask for a school site later. This is a process we have used on other potential sites where we are unsure of the need for a primary school in a locality, as a primary school requirement is based on children not yet born or moved to the area. Through the process we have made it clear to the parties involved that a primary school would be unlikely to be required if Rickman's Green is a standalone settlement as there are currently surplus primary school places in the wider planning area.

We hope this letter will help manage the expectations of the local community about the certainty of a new school to serve Rickman's Green.
