Ref: Local Plan Review - Bethwines Farm.

We object most strongly to any development on Bethwines Farm as this will extend the village further into the open countryside which is full of wild life. If the developers obtain permission for 250 their option agreement would mean they could build up to 1000 - inconceivable.

We have owned Woodlands Farm for forty years and clay lane was then a quiet country road today it's a rat run as is Blackboy lane and Salthill road with vehicles avoiding the Fishbourne roundabout. Also heavy lorries all day are coming and going from Potlocks Industrial Park and crossing the grass verges on roads that are already in a bad state of repair - more traffic NO Fishbourne will no longer be a village but an urban sprawl from Chichester to Bostham.

The Doctors and school will also be put under more pressure:
