Chichester Local Plan Review - Regulation 18 Preferred Options Consultation

Paragraph 4.22

1. Paragraph 4.22 of the Local Plan Review states that:

"This Plan seeks to make provision for an additional 12,350 dwellings to be delivered during the period 2016-2035 in accordance with the findings of the Chichester Housing and Economic Development Needs Assessment (HEDNA). This reflects the identified objectively assessed housing needs of the plan area, plus an allowance for accommodating unmet need arising from the Chichester District part of the South Down National Park."

 Given that the Plan will be submitted to the Secretary of State for Examination post 24th January 2019 it will be examined in accordance with the provisions of the NPPF 2018. Paragraph 60 of the NPPF is clear that:

"To determine the minimum number of homes needed, strategic policies should be informed by a local housing needs assessment, <u>conducted using the standard method in national</u> <u>planning guidance</u> - unless exceptional circumstances justify an alternative approach..." (our emphasis)

- Accordingly, at face value, the references to a HEDNA and 'objectively assessed housing needs' are incorrect and misleading. Instead, the housing requirement in the Local Plan Review should be derived from a local housing needs assessment based on the standard methodology, and this should be clearly stated here.
- 4. Despite the confused references, it seems as though the HEDNA document is in fact a document that sets out how the standard methodology has been applied (correctly utilising the 2014-based household projections in accordance with the clear guidance provided by the government in the 'Technical consultation on updates to national planning policy and guidance' October 2018). The 12,350 additional dwellings identified for the period 2016 -2035 is consistent with the application of the standard method (whilst additionally accommodating unmet needs of 41dpa from the South Downs National Park).
- 5. However it is important to note that this standard methodology figure for Chichester is a figure capped at 40% above the average annual housing requirement in accordance with PPG ID. 2a-004.

As set out in further detail in our representations to Policy S4, this means that there are genuine needs for Chichester that are not being met by the application of this cap yet there seems to have been no consideration on whether delivering a higher number, closer to or meeting the standard methodology 'uncapped' figure, was achievable.

Proposed Changes

Amend the supporting text to Policy S3, including paragraph 4.22, to ensure that references are consistent with the language and approach required by the NPPF 2018 and the PPG.
