Chichester Local Plan Review - Regulation 18 Preferred Options Consultation

Policy AL6 - Land South-West of Chichester (Apuldram and Donnington Parishes)

- 1. Land South-West of Chichester ("the Site") is allocated to deliver approximately 33 hectares of employment land and a minimum of 100 dwellings, as well as a new link road. For the reasons set out below, we have significant reservations with respect to the deliverability of housing from this proposed allocation.
- 2. The Council acknowledges at paragraph 6.47 of the Plan that the impacts of developing the Site, along with its commercial attractiveness, need to be tested further. It is clear, therefore, that the Council does not currently have sufficient evidence to demonstrate the suitability or deliverability of this site. Due to the lack of any flexibility in terms of housing supply (see our representations to Policy S4) this raises significant questions as to the Council's ability to meet the identified housing requirement.
- 3. Furthermore, whilst there is no specific assessment in the Preferred Approach Sustainability Appraisal October 2018 ("SA"), it is evident that the Issues and Options SA (May 2017) confirmed that the Site scored poorly against a number of the assessment criteria. Most notably:
 - Ecology the SA concludes that development of the Site would have an adverse impact on bat and barn owl habitats, as well as the east-west movement of wildlife. Furthermore, the site is within close proximity of the Chichester Harbour Special Protection Area ("SPA") and has the potential to cause adverse impacts in this regard (as acknowledged in the May 2017 SA against assessment criterion 3c);
 - Waste water treatment capacity there is very limited headroom within the existing facility at Apuldram (sited within close proximity of the Site). Policy AL6 states that proposals will need to demonstrate that there is sufficient capacity in the sewer network but it is unclear whether this can be demonstrated. This raises further doubts with respect to the deliverability of the Site; and
 - Chichester Harbour AONB the Site is situated immediately adjacent to the Chichester Harbour AONB where the NPPF confirms that great weight should be afforded to

protecting the setting of the AONB. There is no evidence to confirm that the proposed development could come forward without an unacceptable impact in this regard;

- Flood risk much of the western portion of the Site is situated within Flood Zone 3 and a watercourse runs through the centre of the Site. The NPPF seeks to direct development away from areas at highest risk of flooding (paragraph 155). Therefore much of the Site is unsuitable for development without significant mitigation, raising further doubts regarding it's the ability to deliver the full extent of development allocated through Policy AL6.
- 4. For these reasons, we consider that there is considerable uncertainty as to the suitability and deliverability of this site to deliver housing. Given the lack of any flexibility in housing supply having regard to Policy S4, this is a critical issue.
