# **Chichester Local Plan Review - Regulation** 18 Preferred Options Consultation

## **Policy S3 - Development Strategy**

- 1. As referenced in our representations to Policy S2, the Local Plan Review identifies Chichester City as the most significant and sustainable settlement in the District.
- 2. Against that background Policy S3 outlines a Development Strategy that seeks to provide for sustainable development in the plan area. Whilst it refers to the dispersal of development across the plan area, it is clear that the majority of planned sustainable growth will be *'at Chichester and within the east-west corridor'* (within which Chichester City is located).
- 3. We wholly support this approach which is broadly consistent with that in the adopted Local Plan.
- 4. The focus for development at and adjacent to Chichester City in the first instance must be central to any sound and sustainable plan. However, as set out elsewhere in our representations, and contrary to the strategy established by Policy S3 (and the available evidence) the Council has, without evidence, failed to allocate land on the eastern side of Chichester City, land that is within the Westhampnett / North East Chichester Strategic Development Location as already identified in the adopted Local Plan and, accordingly, already accepted by the Council as one of, if not the, most sustainable locations for development in the District.
