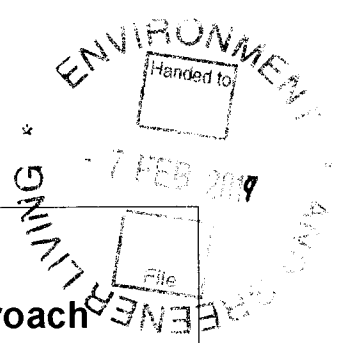

Policy DM24 & SP28 Air Quality
