Hunston's open countryside is only available on one side of the village - the canal cuts the village off completely from access to the other side. We have a duty to provide for housing needs, but not on this green field, please. There are lots of other green fields, even closer to the village centre which could provide smaller but sympathetically situated sites, closer to the B2145, but prevent the gobbling up of more beautiful countryside to provide roads to the large development, situated well away from the 'centre' of the village which could result in more private car use from residents wishing to access services, and those beyond the village, causing more congestion, pollution, etc.
